GUIDELINE

1. Medium of the Olympiads

All MSO Olympiads will be conducted in English.

2. School Codes

Each school receives a unique 6-digit code from MSO when it registers for the Olympiads. Schools should contact the MSO Head Office if they do not know their code.

3. Registration Procedure

Schools must complete all columns of the SRF (School Registration Form) and SRS (Student Registration Sheet) accurately and legibly and submit them before the due date. Schools are requested to display the enclosed posters on notice boards, classrooms, or other prominent places. Students must register through their schools only. Individual or direct registrations will not be accepted. Schools may register in one of the following ways:

- Fill out and courier the registration forms.
- Fill out, scan, and email the registration forms.
- Register online at www.meritsearcholympiad.com

4. Teacher Handbook

Syllabus for each olympiad is mentioned in prospectus and website. They can also be downloaded from the MSO website. Exam Format: All questions are multiple-choice questions (MCQ). There is no negative marking. Schools must choose one available date to conduct the exam. They must conduct it strictly on that chosen date only. Different sets of question papers are provided for each date, and non-adherence to the chosen date may lead to cancellation of the exam.

5. OMR Sheets

Students must fill in all columns of the OMR sheet correctly. Any incorrect in complete information may lead to disqualification from ranking. A sample OMR sheet is available on the MSO website.

6. After the Exam

Answer sheets should be returned to the MSO Head Office next day of the exam. Schools must ensure the answer sheets reach the MSO Head Office within 7 days of the exam date. MSO will not evaluate any answer sheets received beyond the stipulated date.

7. Results

Results are typically declared about 8 weeks after the answer sheets are received. They will be sent to the respective schools and will also be uploaded on the MSO website.

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

1. Students can register only through their schools.
2. Direct registration will not be accepted.

Registration fee is Rs. 200/- per Olympiad

Schools can register in following ways:

1. Fill out and courier the registration forms.
2. Fill out, scan and email the registration forms.

EXAM FORMAT

- All MSO EXAMS will be conducted in English.
- All questions are multiple choice questions (mcqs). There is no negative marking.
- School must choose one available date to conduct the exam. Different dates are available for each exam and different sets of question papers are provided for each date.
- Exams will be conducted in OMR Sheets. After the exam, OMR Sheets should be returned to the MSO Head office within 7 days of the exam date.
- MSO will not evaluate any answer sheets received after deadline.

STUDY MATERIALS:

MSO believes stress-free exams & competition beyond books, that is why we don't put pressure to have separate study material.

We have described our syllabus for Olympiads.

Students can practice from any book.

Results will be sent to the respective schools and will also be uploaded on MSO website.

SYLLABUS



MSO MATHEMATICS

Section 1:
Logical Reasoning Section contains questions related to Patterns, classifications, analogies etc. Verbal and Non-Verbal Reasoning.

Section 2:
Mathematical Reasoning Section in which questions are based on the topics relevant to the current and previous class Maths Syllabus.

Section 3:
Everyday Mathematics Section in which the syllabus is same as that of Section 2. However, the questions are more of the type of Everyday Mathematics and not related to reasoning.

Section 4:
Achievers Section which also covers questions based on the topics of Section 2 but the level of questions is higher. It is advisable to start this section only after the other three sections are complete.



MSO SCIENCE

Section 1:
Logical Reasoning Section which mainly deals with the questions related to Verbal and Non Verbal Reasoning.

Section 2:
Science Section which covers all the relevant topics and sub-topics of current and previous class Science Syllabus.

Section 3:
Achiever's Section which contains Higher Order Thinking Questions of same topics as in Section 2. It is advisable to move to this section only after you have completed the previous two.



MSO ENGLISH

Section 1:
is the basic section and the topics are different according to classes. Some examples of the topics found in it are Synonyms, Spellings, Collocations etc.

Section 2:
is the section which has questions of searching and retrieving information type. The topics differ as usual.

Section 3:
contains questions which test the students ability to understand situation-based functions of various topics.

Section 4:
is the final section which consists of some Higher Order Thinking questions. The topics covered in this section are same as those of the previous three sections.



MSO GENERAL KNOWLEDGE

Section 1:
General Awareness - topics based on important events around the world

Section 2:
Current Affairs - contains questions from recent events.

Section 3:
Life Skills - topics based on abilities for managing and living a better quality of life.

Section 4:
Achievers Section - contains Higher Order Thinking Skills questions

For Std 1 to 5 : Number of Questions : 35 Duration : 60 minutes

For Std 6 to 10 : Number of Questions : 50 Duration : 60 minutes



MSO COMPUTER SCIENCE

Section 1:
contains questions related to Patterns, classifications, analogies etc.

Section 2:
contains questions related to the topics and sub-topics relevant to the class in which the student is. Some topics which could be found here are Fundamentals of Computers, Hardware, Evolution of Computers etc.

Section 3:
consists of the questions of Higher Order Thinking
